

## Active Essex Governance Statement 2022/23

Active Essex is one of 43 Active Partnerships across England. Working with a wide range of local partners, we are the strategic lead for physical activity and sport across Greater Essex. Our work is driven by our system strategy – [“Fit for the Future”](#).

Active Essex is hosted by Essex County Council within the Public Health function. It reports to an independent Board, chaired by Dr William Bird, with 8 [other Board members](#) (selected on skills basis) who hold the executive team to account and is responsible for the strategic direction and leadership of Active Essex.

### Board Meetings

The Board is led currently by a Chair, supported by a Senior Independent Board Member (Vice Chair). In addition, there is an Audit Committee which monitors and scrutinises finance, governance, and wider risk management.

Diversity is important to the Board. Essex seeks to lead and champion good practice for EDI, achieving its Sport England Board composition targets early and has been an early adopter of the Race Code.

All Board members receive a formal induction process and have access to ongoing training and development. New Board Members received formal induction training at the start of their appointment and all Board Members received updated training and Continued Professional Development as required.
