## Stay Safe and Stay Seen with St Claires

During road safety week, 17th - 23rd November, the Clacton and Jaywick Essex Pedal Power team went to St Claires to teach the children how to stay safe and be visible while cycling.

As the morning and afternoons continue to get darker in the winter months, it's important for the children to also learn how to be seen on the roads.

The team taught the children how to be safe and be seen when cycling to and from school. Covering subjects such as wearing helmets, high-visibility clothing, using hand signals and bike maintenance. To ensure the children are seen in the dark, everyone was given free lights for their bikes.

These measures help ensure that children are not only visible but also aware of how to navigate roads safely.
